

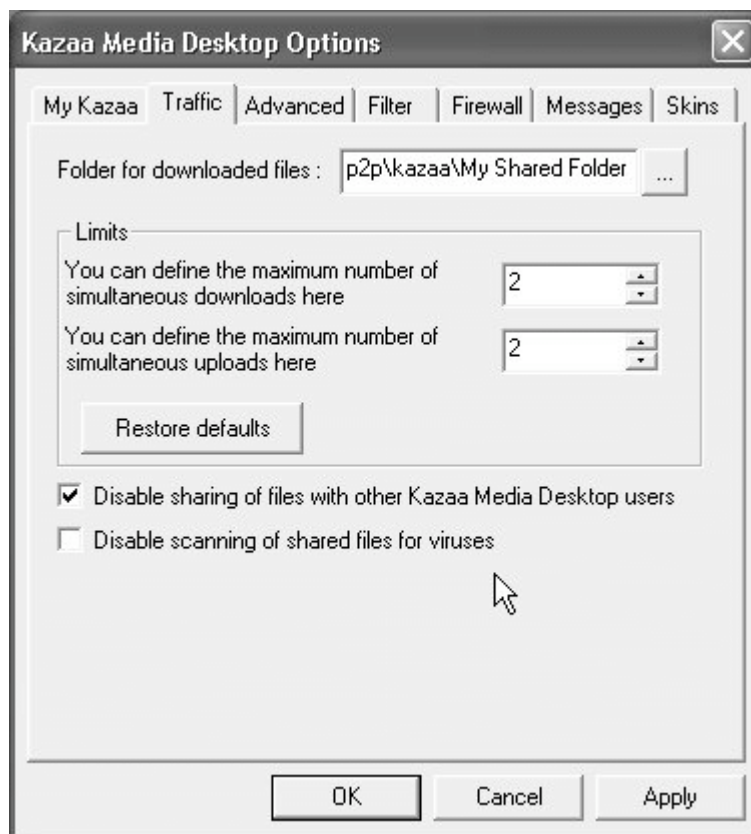

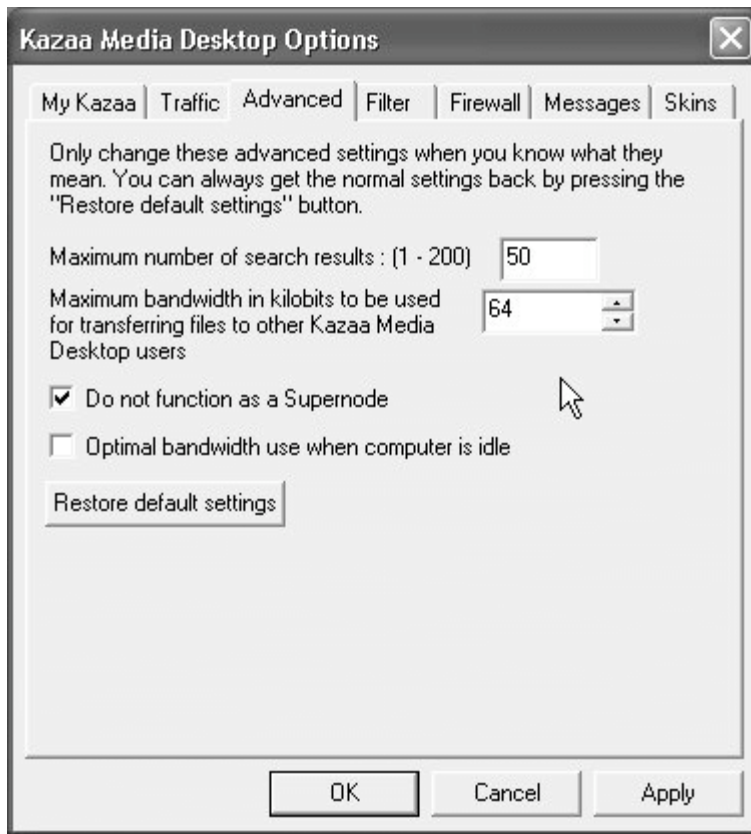
INSTRUCTIONS FOR REDUCING KAZAA'S NETWORK USAGE

In KaZaa 2, go to the Tools menu and select Options. In the box that opens, click the Traffic tab.



This is where you can disable uploads, as well as reduce the number of uploads and downloads that can run at the same time. We strongly recommend disabling uploads entirely. To do this, simply check the box next to "Disable sharing of files with other Kazaa Media Desktop users." If you prefer to continue sharing files, however, we ask that you limit the number to two. Additionally, we recommend that you limit the number of simultaneous downloads to five. Note that this will increase your download speed as well as making the network faster for others.

Next, click on the Advanced tab.



We require that you uncheck the box labeled “Function as a supernode” in this panel. Functioning as a supernode dramatically increases the load on the network. You will not lose any functionality by disabling this option. Also make sure that you uncheck “Optimal bandwidth use when computer is idle.”

When you open KaZaa, if the program asks you whether you would like to update, say No. Updating will return all of the settings you have just changed to the defaults.

Sharing files on the on-campus network is much more fast and efficient than over KaZaa. We encourage you to share files over the local network and to check the local network for files you want before resorting to KaZaa.
